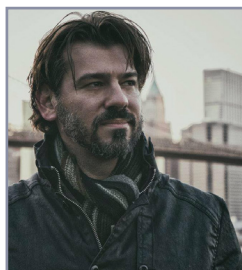


## MEMBERS OF THE COSMOS FM FAMILY

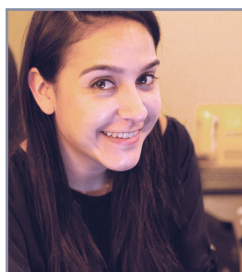
### THANOS DAVELIS

### GRIGORIS MANINAKIS

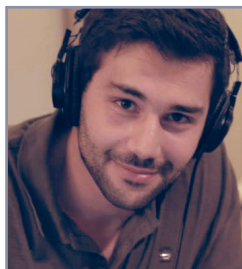
